## WHAT'S THE MOVEMENT ALL ABOUT?

The My Tiny Trash Movement is a program initiated by the office of Sustainability in order to help reduce our carbon footprint on campus and promote environmental awareness. Since the start of the program, recycling rates have doubled from 33% to 66% on campus

## WHAT EXACTLY IS A "TINY" TRASH CAN?

The “tiny” trash is essentially a small waste bin that gets attached to the side of a recycling bin. The trash can is a small size in order \ to encourage more materials to get recycled.

## WHAT GOES IN THE TINY TRASH CAN?
